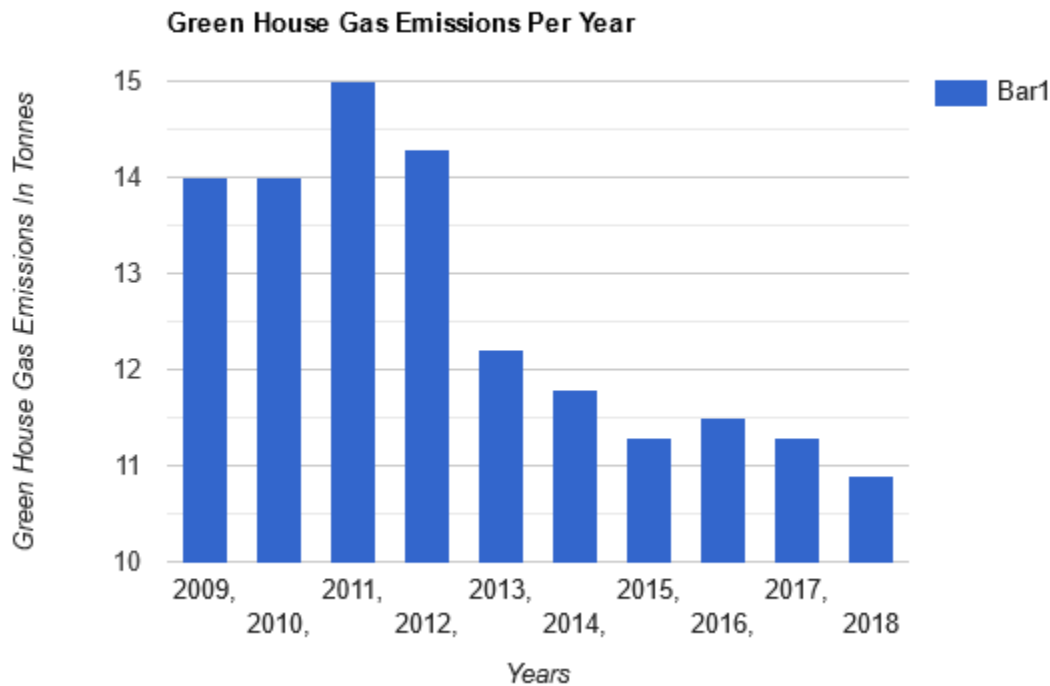


THIS! IS CANADA

Interpretation

The graph above displays the effect of people from my community, Charlottetown, PEI, on the environment. It displays the amount of greenhouse gas emissions per tonne per year. Greenhouse gases are gases released into the air that affect the climate, such as CO₂. Greenhouse gases such as CO₂ are released into the atmosphere through burning fossil fuels, land-use change, industrial production, etc. The data covers nine years of greenhouse gas emissions and shows that the average number released is sitting at around 11.2 tonnes.
