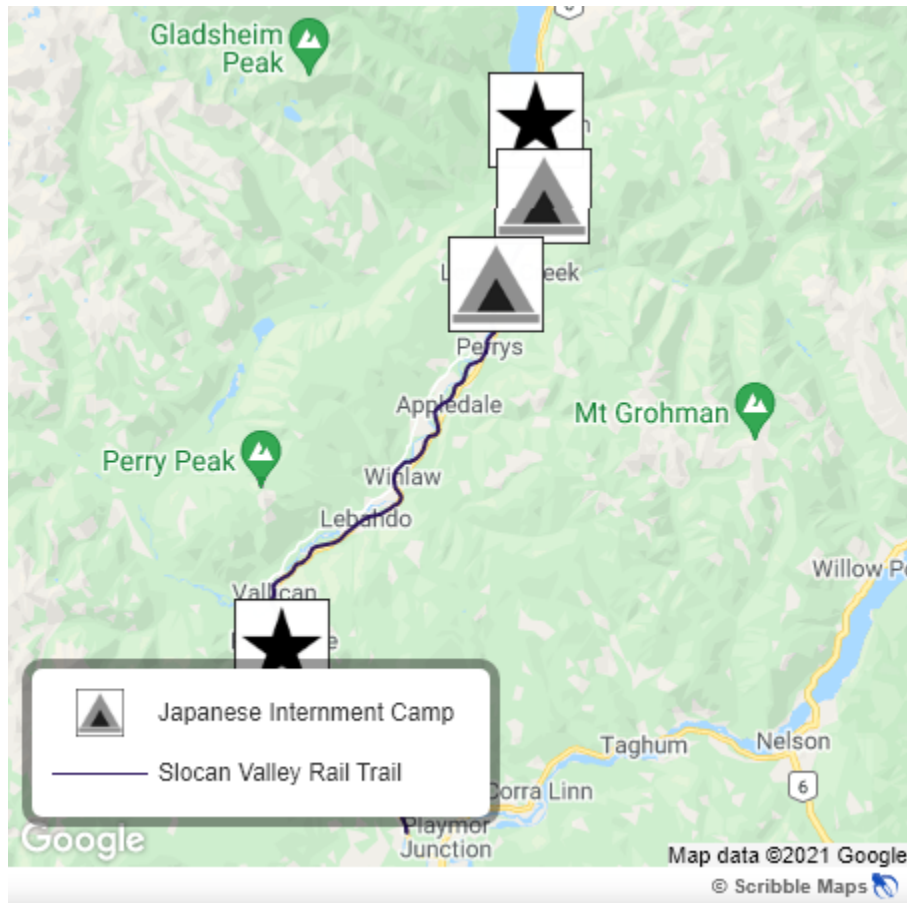

Slocan Valley Rail Trail and Japanese Internment Camps



As you walk along the Slocan Valley Rail Trail, you come across the locations where Japanese internment camps used to be. This is where the Canadian government forcibly interned Japanese Canadians during World War II. They lost all their possessions and land. There was no legal reason for them being put in a camp. At the end of the war they had two choices: move back to Japan or work as a labourer.
